Program Guidelines

- For Clay County residents,
 60 or older.
- Home safety repairs or modifications may be provided to any home the older adult resides in as long as combined household income meets income guidelines.
- Emphasis is on safety related repairs.
- Repairs limited to \$1500.00 per client per year (may include supplies and services of paid contractor).
- Client must be willing to sign waiver to release CCSS and provider of any liability for work provided by contractor.



Home Repair Program

for Clay County Older Adults

Acceptable repairs may include:

- Purchasing & installing grab bars, handheld showerheads, handrails, & other limited safety modification equipment
- Replacing or repairing stair railings
- ♦ Installing locks or security devices
- Changing light bulbs
- Replacing batteries in smoke alarms
- ♦ Building ramps
- Repairing or replacing steps and walkways
- ♦ Replacing switches and outlets
- Repairing faucets, leaking toilets, sinks, and bathtubs
- Installing or fixing garbage disposals
- Repairing washers or dryers
- Lighting pilot lights and changing filters on furnaces or water heaters
- Installing weather stripping, caulking and grouting
- Repairing doors and windows
- ♦ Gutter repairing; cleaning once a year.
